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


### How to Update Your iPhone, iPad, and Android Device

If your mobile device is not compatible with our app then it may be running an unsupported version of iOS or Android. The Anytime Pediatrics app is compatible with Apple devices running iOS 13 and Android devices running Oreo 8.0 and newer.







## Check & update your Android version

You can find your device's Android version number, security update level, and Google Play system level in your Settings app. You'll get notifications when updates are available for you. You can also check for updates.

### See which Android version you have

- 1. Open your phone's Settings app.
- 2. Near the bottom, tap System > Advanced > System update.
- 3. See your "Android version" and "Security patch level."

## Get the latest Android updates available for you

When you get a notification, open it and tap the update action.

If you cleared your notification or your device has been offline:

- 1. Open your phone's Settings app.
- 2. Near the bottom, tap System > Advanced > System update.
- 3. You'll see your update status. Follow any steps on the screen.

If your device does not allow you to update to a new version then you will need to use a different mobile device that supports at least iOS 13 or Android Oreo 8.0 and above.
