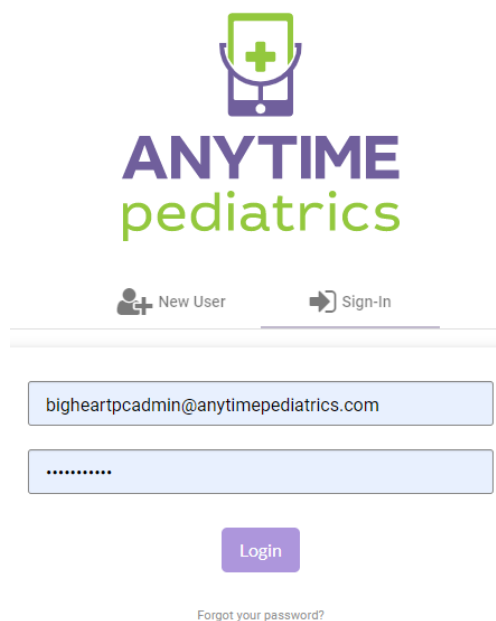

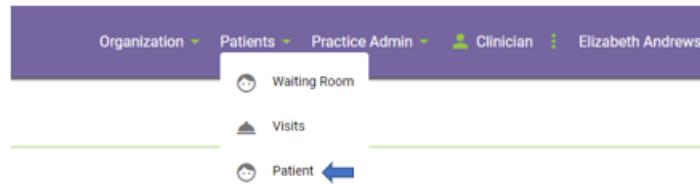
Prenatal Workflow

Follow the workflow below to provide prenatal pediatric care using the Anytime Pediatrics platform.

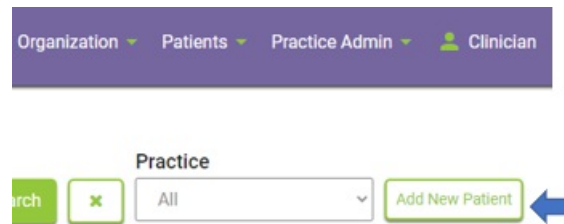
- Log in to the Anytime Pediatrics [platform](#) using a Google Chrome web browser.



- Click on the patient tab at the top of your screen, and select patient.



- Select Add New Patient



- Fill out the required patient fields with the expecting mother's information
